I hope this finds you well.

Today our Year 8s had their **immunisations** at school. If for any reason your child missed these can you please let the School know.

Last week saw the whole School enjoying a one day Science presentation. This was a great way to get students to start to think about "putting things to the test" which is the inquiry learning focus at School this term.

This weekend we have three of our students entering the Auckland Regional Chinese Language Competition. This is a competition for non-Chinese children and to gain any placing is a huge achievement. All our classes are taught mandarin so they are all able to enter this if they are up to it. We wish our representatives well in this.

This week is NEW ZEALAND SIGN LANGUAGE WEEK. Throughout the school all students will be learning some sign language this week.

As it is getting a bit cooler and we are encouraging children to wear their polar fleeces. At this time of year, when the day can start off cold then warm up, students remove uniform and so it is very important that children have their **clothes named**. We always seem to end up with a lot of lost property because clothing is not named and we have no way of getting them back to their owner! This week we are moving to a new, more effective model for providing Homework Support to students. Every teacher will be emailing you this week letting you know times over the coming weeks when they will provide either before or after School homework support in their class for their students (8.00 -8.45am or 3.00 - 4.00pm). This is going to be much better in terms of effectively supporting students. The homeroom teacher has the most well established relationship of all with children and so it makes a lot more sense to do it this way. This means that there will be no further AFTER SCHOOL **HOMEWORK** in the LIBRARY.

The Value that we are focusing on right now is **RESPECTFUL**. We want our children to be respectful! Having respect for themselves, for others and for the environment is what we want our children to learn.



Social Workers in Schools (SWIS) is a free, confidential and voluntary service that is available to families and children in primary and intermediate schools.

SWIS have three main roles:

- 1. One on one work with children and their families/whanau.
- 2. Provide group programmes which help children and families succeed.
- 3. Help families to access community support and networks.
