I urge you to check regularly with your son/daughter, to check what they are sending, receiving and putting up onto things like Instagram. We encourage children every week at assembly, to speak up about anything that they are not happy about. 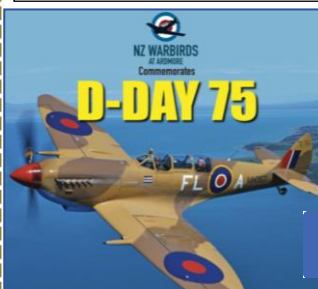
