FROM OUR PRINCIPAL

CONTACTING YOUR CHILD'S TEACHER

From time to time you will want to contact your child's homeroom teacher. Our teaching team put in long hours and one of the things that we want to ensure this year is that teachers are not being contacted at home at night or during the weekend. Like all of us they have families of their own.

Times when you can meet face to face with your child's teacher are: Any week day from 8.15am to 4.00pm by appointment. If you need to contact your child's teacher you can expect a response Monday – Friday from 8.15am to 5pm. I am always able to be contacted on my cell phone any day at all.
