

From our Principal

Kia ora e te Whānau o Henderson Intermediate,

I hope this newsletter finds you and your whanau in good spirits and health.

We are now embarking on our eighth week of the term with Easter fast approaching. Please check the dates for the many events happening in our kura as well as the easter dates and end of term. This week alone we have a Tags Tournament, Western Zone Orienteering and on Friday a Petangue competition. What a range of talents our students have.

Last Wednesday we held our Athletics day, it was fantastic to see all of our students getting involved and having a great day. Thank you to all of the staff, this is truly a team effort.

We as a school are trying very hard to lift our student attendance. We want our students to attend our school because we want to make a difference to their lives and their learning. The government's aim is to have 70% of our students attending 90% of the time. We are currently sitting at 62-68%. We cannot engage our students if they do not attend. Below is a table to

HAPPY EASTER


