This term we are working with clay. We are looking at ancient Greek pots, vases and vessels, and then designing our own contemporary version.

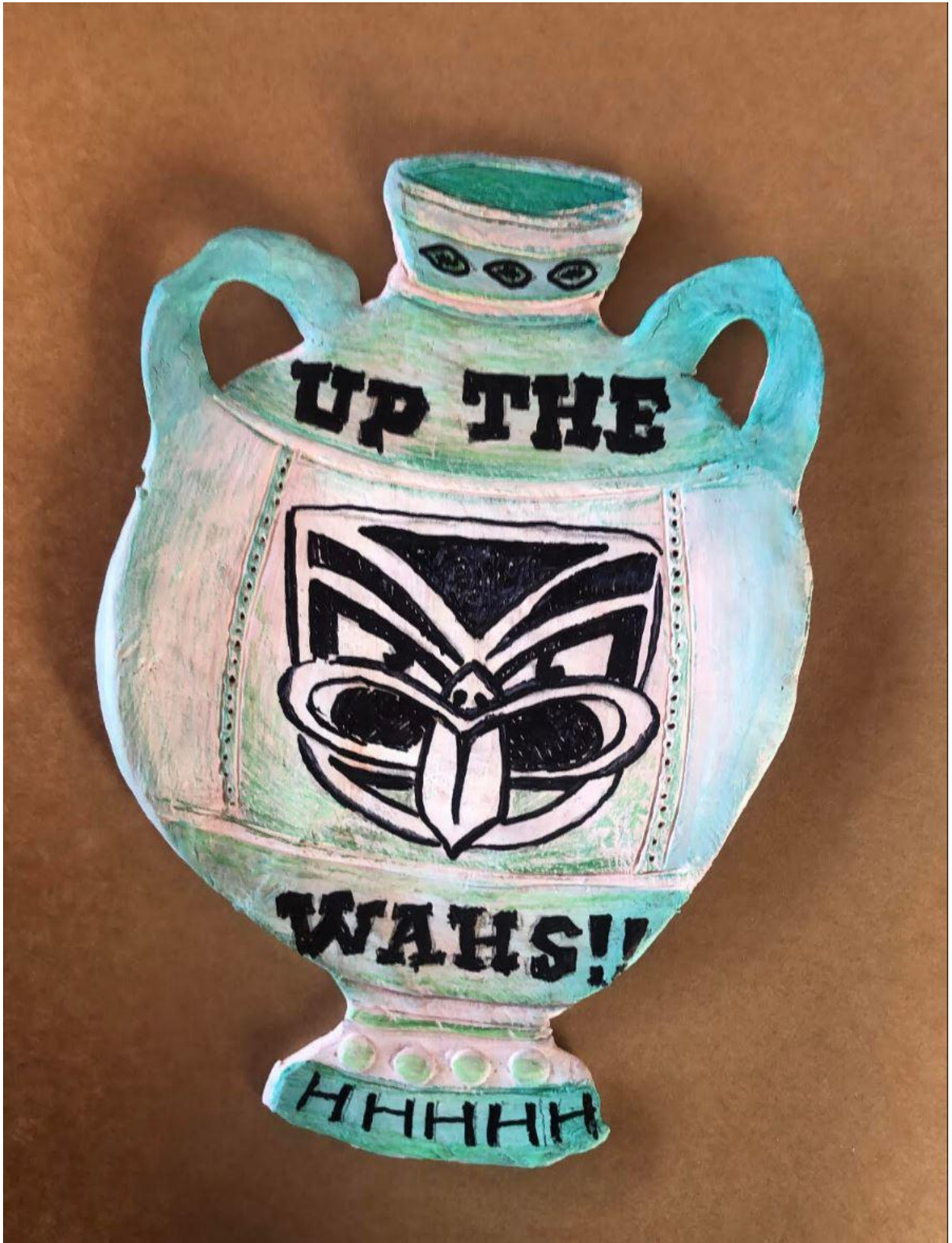

Avondale College Open Evening 2023: Wed 26 July

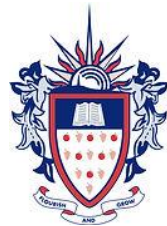
