Warmest Greetings to you all

What a change we had in temperature over the weekend! Let's hope that this cold, wet snap is short lived.

The Board has now approved the **astro turf** to go under the atrium area. With the big new build we are also looking at costings to get the whole court area also astro turfed. There is such a lot of exciting work being done right now around the school. Our children are very lucky!

PE gear is becoming a bit of an issue. We understand that our Year 8s are growing and have grown since they started with us, on that basis we are allowing the Year 8s to wear either plain black or plain navy blue shorts for their PE. These are very cheap at places like Kmart and The Warehouse.

Some students are getting nose piercings done. In our student enrolment paperwork parents agree and sign to their children only wearing a single stud in their ear. If your child is getting a nose piercing done then they need to either be wearing a very small gold stud, clear coloured

stud or simply cover it with a small plaster. We cannot accept responsibility for any injury caused by students wearing these. This is a safety issue for us here.

Accidents happen sometimes at school and it is important that when families are called about coming to collect children that, if for any reason the pick up of the child is not able to happen immediately, we are told so we can take the child over to the hospital ourselves. We do this often but we do this when we are told by the family that they cannot come right away to collect their child themselves. Last week we had a situation where a child waited over an hour for family to collect them. None of us want to see children suffering, neither their family nor staff.

No questions will be asked. This is because it matters to us that your children are happy and ready to go in the new school year.


