
Attendance at School



Sports Technology

In Sports Tech, students will develop catching, and throwing skills to apply in games of cricket or softball. As part of their skill development, students are learning about the "Cookie Jar" throwing technique. A throw that keeps the ball flat and hard, to ensure that the ball remains catchable throughout the flight. Activities for catching include working with a partner through a range of catching drills. The main focus is developing personal skills, and learning to work collectively as a team.

In the remaining terms of the year, students can look forward to team based activities such as Volleyball, Basketball and Modified American Football.




